TREEFORT MUSIC FEST CELEBRATES TEN YEARS

BOISE, IDAHO – March 31, 2022 – The tenth Treefort Music Fest took place last week on March 23-27, 2022. After holding a scaled-back festival in September 2021, Treefort celebrated its tenth anniversary festival with amazing weather and a full five-days of music and arts programming in multiple venues throughout downtown Boise, Idaho.

Attendance

Treefort saw 25,000 unique attendees over the five-day festival, with an average daily attendance of 12,000 attendees. Saturday was the most popular day to attend the fest with about 15,000 attendees. Nearly 55% of those attending Treefort 10 were from Idaho, while 45% traveled from out of state to attend the fest, including bands, fans, media, staff, and volunteers.

In comparison to past festivals, Treefort 10 shaped up to very similar attendance as Treefort 8 in 2019. However, Treefort 10 saw more five-day passholders than previous festivals. Nearly 10,000 five-day passholders were at the fest, including fans, bands, staff, volunteers, media, and sponsors.

Venues + Events

Treefort 10 was the festival's largest footprint yet with 60 total venues spread all around downtown Boise. A total of 941 official events took place over the five days of Treefort 10, with additional unofficial events happening at multiple locations throughout the city. Of those, there were 683 live music events, 288 art events, and 591 all ages events.

More than 500 bands and artists played at Treefort 10 – the largest lineup yet for Treefort Music Fest. A total of 186 local artists played at Treefort 10, along with artists hailing from 35 US states and 19 different countries.

Community

Treefort is made possible by its community. Treefort 10 had roughly 165 staff and crew members, 25 venue managers, nearly 40 sound and light technicians, and roughly 600 volunteers. Nearly 50 local businesses contributed to artist hospitality. Two giant puppets made by Colossal Collective, a praying mantis and a pangolin, were roaming at Treefort 10.

Health

Treefort 10 had covid testing and vaccinations on site. In total, 37 tests were performed, all of which had negative results, and a total of 42 covid vaccines were administered.

Treefort 11

Save the date for Treefort 11 on March 22-26, 2023! Next year, Treefort will have a new Main Stage location and a new venue: Treefort Music Hall, 722 W. Broad Street in downtown Boise.
